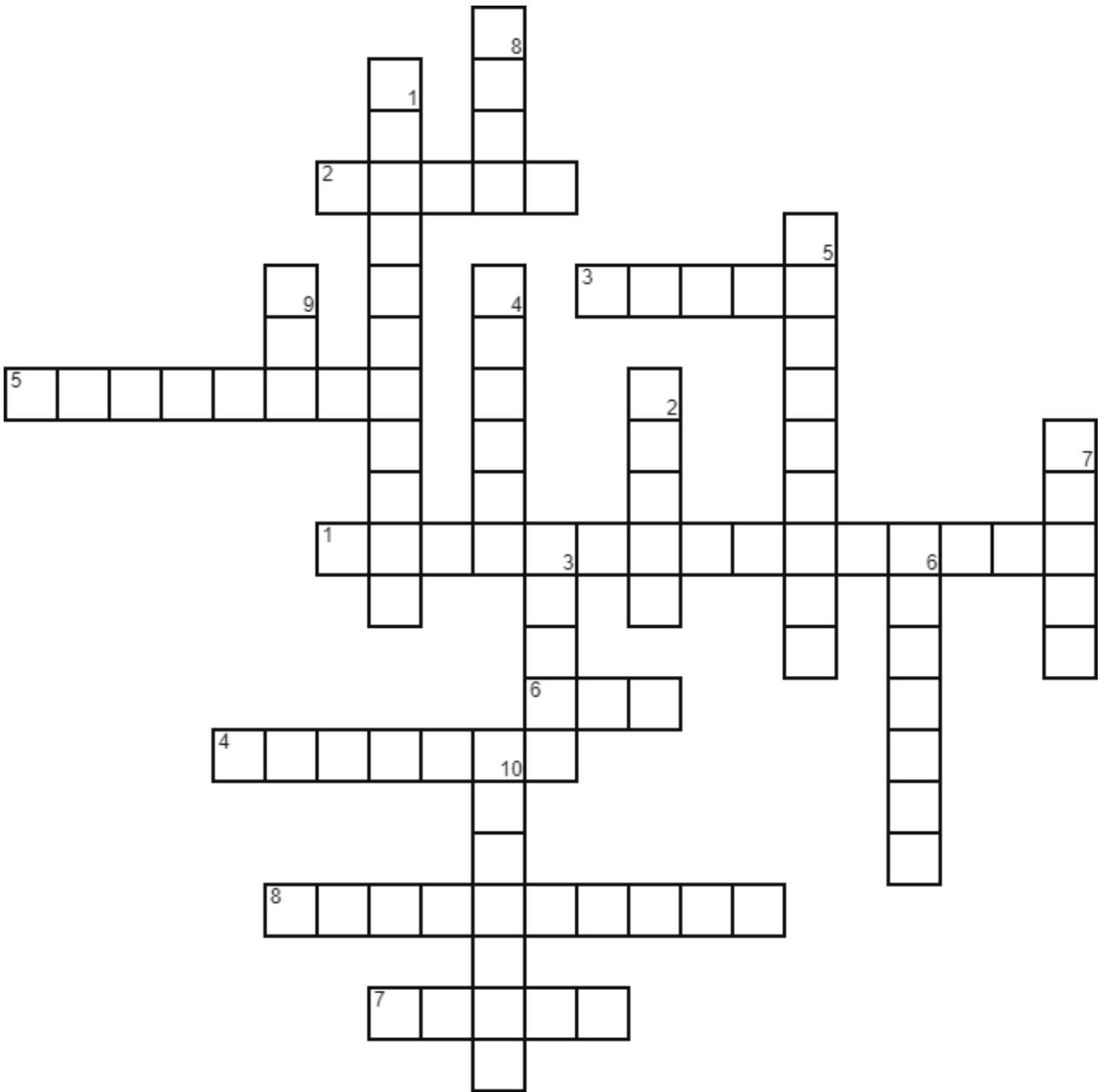

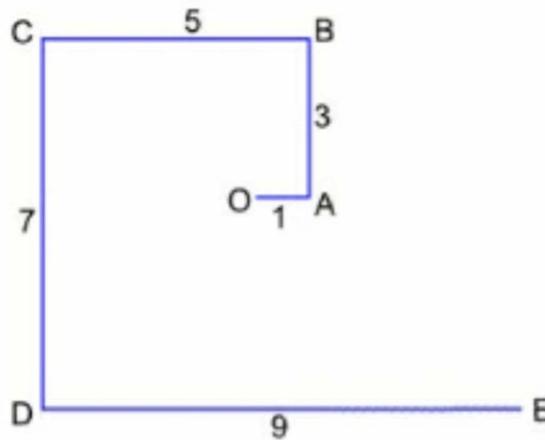

Topic: Matter in Our Surroundings

Sub Topic : Plasma, 4th State of Matter

You may have already learnt about three states of matter i.e. solids, liquids and gases .

Did you know that there is a fourth state of matter called **Plasma**.

Let us take the example of ice. When ice is heated sufficiently it melts to form water. It has undergone a change of state from a solid to a liquid state.

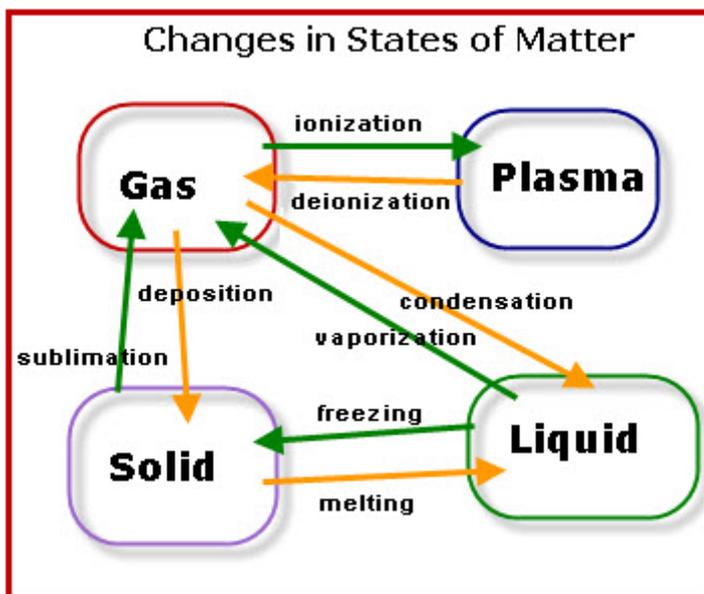
In a solid all particles are closely packed therefore they have a fixed shape and volume. In a liquid the particles touch one another and are able to move and therefore liquid has a fixed volume but takes the shape of the container.

What is the change of state when water is heated to 100 degrees.

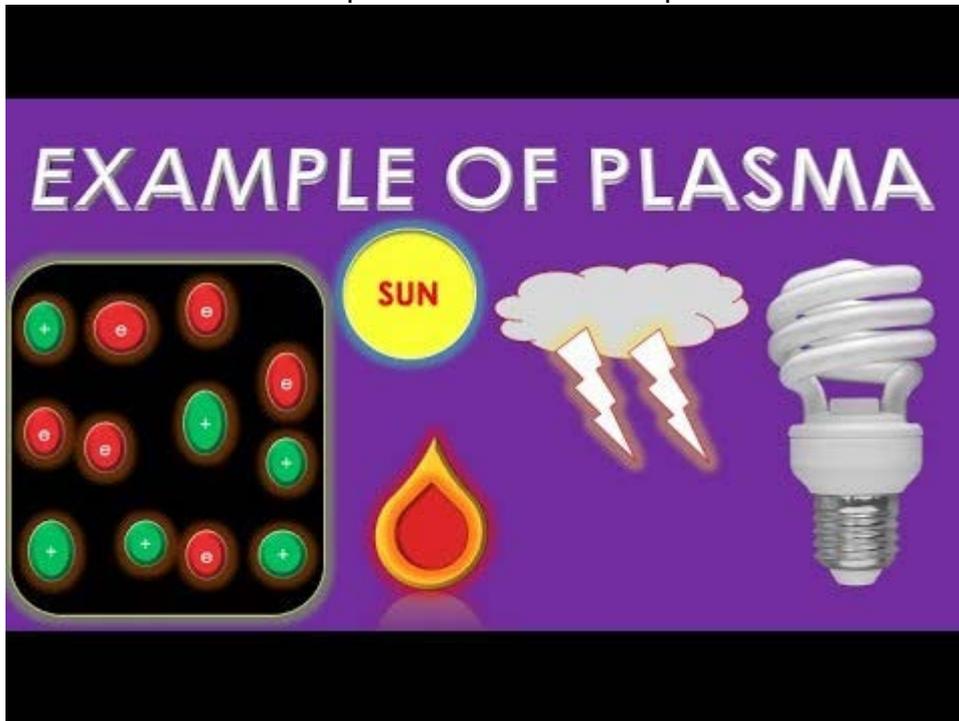
The answer is that water evaporates from a liquid to a gas and forms water vapour. The particles in a gas are further away from one another and take shape and volume of container.

For some substance if we continue to supply heat the gaseous form another change of state occurs. The substance can go from gaseous state to another state of matter called plasma.



For this change of state very strong heat is required. When heat is sufficiently strong, electrons get ripped from their respective atoms creating free electrons and positive ions. Although there are both positive and negative particles, plasma is neutral.

Since free electrons are present substances in plasma form can conduct electricity.



Naturally occurring plasma include lightning and northern lights. If you were to go far beyond, stars also exist in plasma form. Infact stars are hot balls of plasma. Plasma can be found in fluorescent bulbs and neon signs. When an electric current is passed through mercury vapour in a fluorescent tube the current heats up the gas sufficiently to strip electrons and create plasma.

Plasma screen TVs are made possible due to this state of matter. A plasma screen is made of many thousands of tiny dots called pixels, which are made of 3 fluorescent light emitting electrodes. The higher the number of pixels, higher the definition of image and it will be sharper and more detailed.
